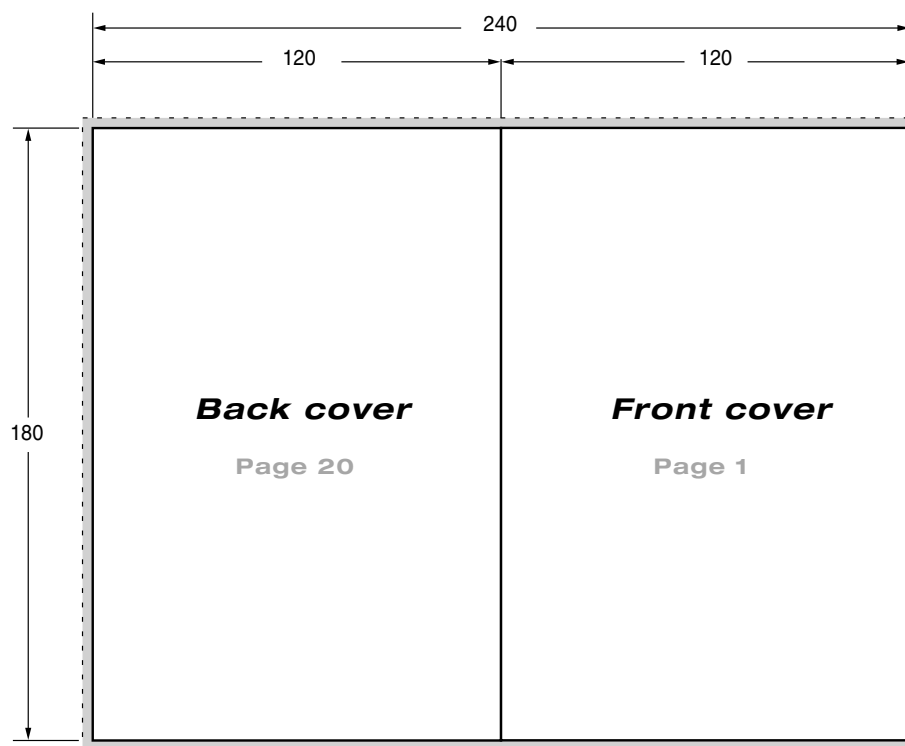

NB: The plan of the layout for booklets with more than 4 pages to process with CTP differ from those used for direct film output.

Printing constraints

The more pages in the booklet the more the inside pages protrude slightly from the opening edge. Therefore you must take this into consideration in your plans and allow for a larger binding margin for the inside pages.

A general guideline is to decrease the page width by 1mm every 24 pages.

Format of finished product :
120 (+0/-1 mm) x 180 mm (+0/-1 mm)

Paper for the cover : 170 ou 150 g gloss -
Inside pages : 170 ou 150 ou 90 g gloss for
booklets of less than 32 pages. 90 g gloss
for booklets of 32 pages or more.

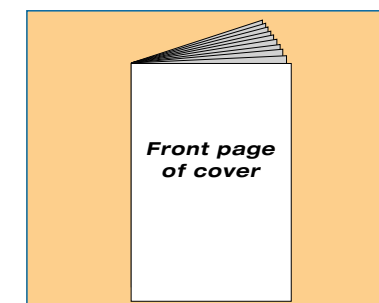
Printing : offset
Primary colours and/or spot tones
(Pantone@colours only)

Finish : gloss dispersion varnish or
without varnish

Packaging : automatic
If the 4 page booklet is inserted with 1 or 2 other
booklets, machine packing only remains possible
when the total number of pages does not exceed 80
(max 3mm)
