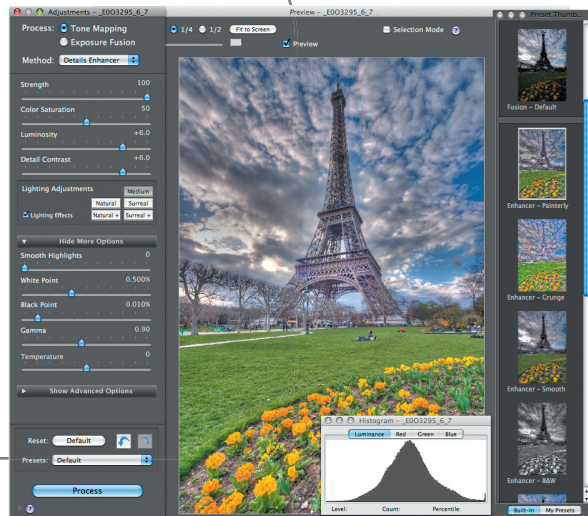
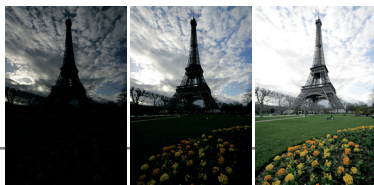

The solution is High Dynamic Range (HDR) processing: take multiple photographs at varying exposure levels and process them in Photomatix Pro. You will get images that display the whole range of details from shadows to highlights.

Photomatix Pro offers several methods and settings to process high contrast scenes and achieve the look you want. From natural-looking results using exposure fusion to painterly, surreal or ultra-realistic using the tone mapping mode.

In addition to tone mapping and exposure fusion tools, Photomatix Pro includes advanced functions to process HDR images, including:

- Automatic alignment of hand-held photos
- Selective & automatic dehosing tools
- High-quality noise reduction
- Chromatic aberrations reduction
- Powerful batch processing

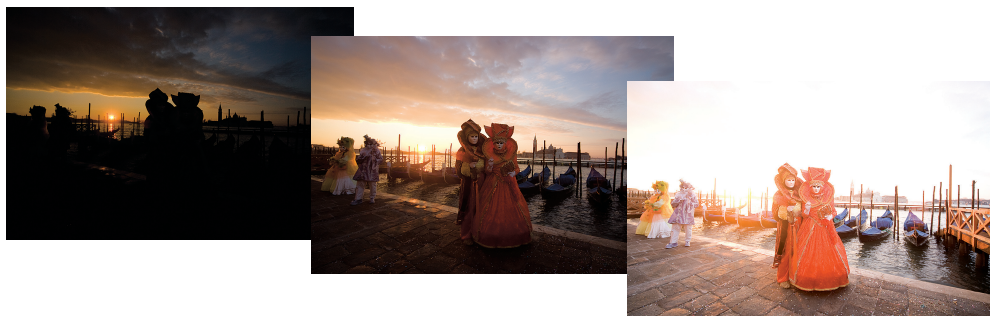
